Identity Documents

Proof of your identity

Provide birth certificate or other ID documents issued by the government

Proof of change of name (if applicable)

marriage or divorce certificate, documents that show other names you have had



English Language Score

Do you meet the English requirement?

You have at least competent English.

Click here to see what scores you need in IELTS, PTE, CAE, OET or TOEFI iBT that will prove you have competent English.



Skilled Employment

Have you worked full time in the last 10 years?

Provide payslips that cover the time period claimed; contracts, tax returns, superannuation documents, any other documents relating to your employment history

Do you have employment references?

Provide written references with the employer's full details (address, phone, signature, position, etc.). Show the exact period of employment, what type of employment, your position and your salary



Qualifications

Do you have the right qualifications?

When you undertake the skills assessment, the assessing authority will decide whether or not your qualifications are comparable the the relevant Australian qualification.



Australian Study Requirement

Do you meet the Australian study requirement?

Provide course transcripts; completion letter/s from the educational institution showing: start/end dates of your course/s, location, date the course requirement was met, any distance learning, full-time or part-time, language of instruction, if credit was granted for a course that meets the Australian study requirement



Relationship Documents

Have you been married, widowed, divorced or permanently separated?

Provide proof in form of divorce documents, death certificates, separation documents or statutory declerations



Health Documents

Did you get your medical checks done?

The medical examination results will be sent straight to the Department of Home Affairs. You do not need to provide additional documents.



Character Documents

Are you of good character?

Provide police certificates (Australian and overseas where applicable).
Provide military service records if you have served in the armed forces only.
Often submitting Form 80 and Form 1221 will help reduce visa processing times as well as your CV (resume).
